#### Major Apple Software Trends

- Better Software Parity on All Platforms
  - In past years iPhones got new features first, followed by iPads in later years, and perhaps eventually Macs
  - With the updates coming this year most new features will appear on all platforms
- Al (which Apple calls Apple Intelligence) is pervasive on all platforms
  - Not really a new thing for Apple since Apple Silicon chips have for years had a Neural Engine that facilitates machine learning
  - Apple has used machine learning for years in Apps like Photos
  - What is new this year is the incorporation of Generative Artificial Intelligence models with machine learning and the use of Large Language Models
  - Much of Apple's Al is performed solely on device for enhanced security
  - But most of the new Apple AI is only compatible with devices using Apple Silicon not Intel devices
- There is definitely a trend away from support of Intel Based Macs, and future software updates will likely not support Intel
  Macs

#### macOS 15 Sequoia Major New Features

- Use your iPhone from your Mac
- iPhone notifications on Mac
- Drag and drop between devices
- Separate Passwords App
- Messages Tapback with any emoji or sticker
- Live audio transcription and math expressions in Notes
- Al based writing, image creation, and Siri enhancements
- Capability to summarize webpages, voice memos, meeting notes, and emails



#### macOS 15 Sequoia Compatibility

iMac (2019 and later)
iMac Pro (2017 and later)
MacBook Air (2020 and later)
MacBook Pro (2018 and later)
Mac Pro (2019 and later)
Mac Studio (2022 and later)
Mac mini (2018 and later)

Compatibility is the same as macOS Sonoma except for MacBook Air, which is compatible only with MacBook Air 2020 and later models

#### MacOS Sequoia Intel Limitations

- Apple Intelligence is only supported on devices containing Apple Silicon (M-series) chips
- Live audio transcription in Apple Notes is only supported on devices containing Apple Silicon (M-series) chips
- Most other features are supported on earlier compatible Macs, although not all capabilities may be fully supported and performance may be somewhat degraded

#### MacOS Sequoia Features Unavailable at Launch

- iPhone drag-and-drop will not be in the initial release but should be available later this year
- Apple Intelligence features will only be available as Beta features when Sequoia is released this fall
  - Mail app's new Al features won't be ready until "later in 2024". These include a redesign that can group emails into categories like newsletters, announcements and shopping.
  - Siri integration with ChatGPT similarly will likely miss the initial release.
  - As the Development Betas progress over the next few months other features may miss the initial release.
  - The major Siri "overhaul" including Personal Context, Semantic Indexing, App Control, and On-screen Awareness will likely not be available until 2025.

- Send messages via satellite when W-Fi and cellular unavailable
- Automatically categorize, group, and summarize email messages
- New Passwords App works across all Apple devices
- Live audio transcription in Notes





- Several new health features like vitals collected while you sleep




#### watchOS 11 Compatibility

- Requires iPhone Xs or later with iOS 18 and one of the following Apple Watch models:
  - Apple Watch SE (2nd generation)
  - Apple Watch Series 6
  - Apple Watch Series 7
  - Apple Watch Series 8
  - Apple Watch Series 9
  - Apple Watch Ultra
  - Apple Watch Ultra 2

Several Apple Watch models that are compatible with watchOS 10 are no longer compatible with watchOS 11
